Update on Aboriginal Housing Strategy

The State Government is committed to working with the South Australian Aboriginal community and partner organisations to develop an Aboriginal Housing Strategy, to improve housing outcomes for Aboriginal people across the State.

Work to develop this Aboriginal Housing Strategy has reached a critical milestone, with state-wide engagement to occur throughout July and early August. This state-wide engagement will be essential to capture the voices of as many Aboriginal South Australians as possible to shape the new strategy.

Following a select tender process, PricewaterhouseCoopers Indigenous Consulting (PIC) has been appointed as the Aboriginal Business Enterprise to work closely with the Authority and Aboriginal Advisory Committee to plan and undertake the state-wide engagement.

In the context of COVID-19 planned engagement activities may be adjusted to align with the State Government's [COVID-19 Recovery Roadmap](#). Specific details of engagement events and opportunities will be released in coming weeks. The SA Housing Authority is committed to ensuring First Nations peoples in SA have the opportunity to be a part of the development and design of this important strategy for South Australia.
